We welcome proposals for 45–60-minute lectures, presentations, and poster sessions. Abstracts must be in English and may include optional translations into **Japanese**, **Korean**, or **Chinese**.

Please include: a) The title of your proposed presentation, b) The type of presentation (lecture, seminar, poster), c) Your name & educational credentials, d) Your affiliation with any IAIP member organization (optional); e) Your contact information (email); f) The 150-200 word abstract (English & Japanese, Korean, or Chinese if needed); g) Major educational objective of your proposed presentation.
